**ORDER**  
**GRANTING CREDITOR'S MOTION TO COMPEL**  
**OR IN THE ALTERNATIVE REQUEST FOR SUBPOENA**

For the reasons articulated in the Court's Memorandum of Decision on the Creditor's Motion to Compel or in the Alternative Request for Subpoena,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Requests to Produce are denied, *but* the Creditor's Alternative Motion for Request of Subpoena is granted. Therefore, the Court directs the Clerk of the Court, pursuant to Fed. R. Bankr. P. Rule 7045, to issue a signed subpoena to the Creditors.
