ORDER CONVERTING CASE UNDER CHAPTER 7
TO CASE UNDER CHAPTER 13 BY DEBTOR

The Debtor has filed a motion, in accordance with 11 USC 706(a), seeking to convert this case to a case under Chapter 13 of the Bankruptcy Code. The Court has considered the record, and finds that the case has not been converted previously under 11 USC 1112 or 1208, or 1307.

IT IS ORDERED THAT, PER MEMORANDUM OF DECISION DATED JULY 11, 2000,

1. This Chapter 7 case is converted to a case under Chapter 13.
2. The Chapter 7 trustee within 30 days of the date of this Order shall file:
 - a. an account of all receipts and disbursements made in the Chapter 7 case, and
 - b. a report on the administration of the case pursuant to 11 USC 704(9).
3. The trustee forthwith shall turn over to the Debtor all records and property of the estate remaining in the trustee's custody and control.
4. The trustee or any other party entitled to compensation may within 30 days of the date of this Order file an application for compensation and reimbursement of expenses.
5. The Debtor within 15 days from the date of this Order shall file the statements and schedules required by Bankruptcy Rule 1007(b), if such documents have not already been filed. If such documents have previously been filed, amendments should be titled "Amendment Due to Case Conversion." No filing fee is required.
6. The Debtor within 15 days of the date of this Order shall file a Chapter 13 Plan.
