TO ADD DOCUMENTS THAT MAY BE FILED VIA THE ELECTRONIC CASE FILING SYSTEM BY NON-ATTORNEYS WHO HAVE NOT BEEN TRAINED BY THE CLERK'S OFFICE

WHEREAS it is the Court's intent to make practicing in this Court as convenient and efficient as possible by encouraging the use of the Electronic Case Filing (ECF) system; and

WHEREAS it has come to the Court's attention that an expansion of the documents that nonattorney, non-registered users may file electronically via ECF would enhance the value and efficiency of the ECF system;

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Local Rules are hereby modified to allow non-attorney, non-registered users, to file a broader range of documents via the ECF system, as follows:

Vt. LBR 5005-4 (b)(2). Registration – Non-Attorneys.

[The second sentence is modified as shown in italics]

"... In order to register, however, one must have already been trained by the Clerk's Office, unless the party seeks only to file a proof of claim, a notice of transfer of claim, a withdrawal of claim, a notice of appearance, or a request for notice."

This modification of the Local Rules is **effective immediately.**
