A voluntary petition by an individual or an individual and spouse may be paid in no more than four (4) installments, upon application to the Court.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>3</sup> This is a mandatory fee in addition to the fee for appeals and cross appeals. It is due upon filing and may not be waived or deferred.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>4</sup> The fee for **requesting** a direct appeal or cross appeal from a bankruptcy court decision to the Court of Appeals is \$298 (\$293 appeal fee + \$5 notice of appeal fee). If the Court of Appeals **authorizes** the direct appeal, an **additional** fee of \$157 is due to the Bankruptcy Court.

The court may defer payment of the fee from trustees pending discovery of additional assets. If payment is deferred, the fee shall be waived if no additional assets are discovered.
