CERTIFICATION OF DECISION
UNDER 28 U.S.C. § 158(d)(2)(A) & (B)

For the reasons set forth in the memorandum of decision of even date, THE COURT FINDS the Trustee has established the criteria required for certification under 28 U.S.C. § 158(d)(2)(A), and in particular finds, first, that the USBC Decision on Remand involves questions of law (a) as to which there is no controlling decision of the Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit and (b) a matter of public importance; and second, that an immediate appeal of the USBC Decision on Remand would materially advance the progress of the cases in which the subject appeal has been taken.

Therefore, THIS COURT CERTIFIES the USBC Decision on Remand reflects the circumstances specified in 28 U.S.C. § 158(d)(2)(A)(i) & (iii) and makes this certification to fulfill its statutory duty, as set out in § 158(d)(2)(B), and in accordance with Bankruptcy Rule 8006.
