WHEREAS, on May 13, 2005, this Court entered a Supplemental Examiner Order (the "May 13<sup>th</sup> Order") limiting notice of the Examiner's Report to certain parties and directed such parties to keep the terms of the Examiner's Report confidential (¶ 2);

WHEREAS, on July 8, 2005, the Examiner filed the Examiner's Report under seal; and

WHEREAS, earlier today, Chanin Capital Partners ("Chanin") filed an Emergency Motion seeking an order clarifying or amending, to permit Chanin to be added to the list of parties to receive a copy of the Examiner's report (the "Chanin Motion");

After due consideration of these three documents and the record in this case, THE COURT FINDS that there has been sufficient notice of the Chanin Motion, that it is appropriate for Chanin to receive a copy of the Examiner's Report and that Berenson & Company, LLC ("Berenson") is in a parallel position to Chanin and is equally entitled to view the Examiner's Report.

Therefore, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that

- 1. the Chanin Motion is granted;
- 2. Chanin may have a copy of the Examiner's Report subject to the confidentiality provisions set forth in the May 13<sup>th</sup> Order;
- 3. the same relief is extended to Berenson *sua sponte*; and
- 4. the Examiner is directed to serve a copy of the Examiner's Report on Chanin and Berenson, in the same manner and to the same extent other parties were served, by 3:00 PM EST today.
