ORDER

Granting Application for Commission and Attorney's Fees for Chapter 7 Trustee and Setting Amount of Commission to be Paid to Chapter 7 Trustee in Chapter 13 Case

For the reasons set forth in the memorandum of decision of even date,

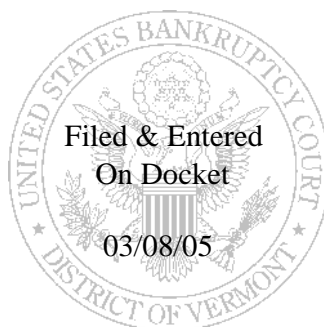
IT IS ORDERED that the Chapter 7 Trustee's Report of All Receipts and Disbursements; and Report on Administration is APPROVED; and,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Application for Compensation and Expenses by Douglas J. Wolinsky, Esq., the chapter 7 Trustee, is APPROVED and the Trustee is ALLOWED commissions in the amount of \$4,680, and reimbursement of expenses in the amount of \$176.00, for a total of \$4,856, and that the chapter 13 Trustee is Authorized to pay such allowed fees and expenses in accordance with the chapter 13 Plan and as statutorily provided; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the present allowance of compensation to the chapter 7 Trustee pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 326, shall not prevent or preclude the chapter 7 Trustee from seeking additional 11 U.S.C. § 326 compensation in the event that this case is reconverted to a case under chapter 7, with the allowance of § 326 compensation under the Order to be considered as part of any such subsequent compensation under 11 U.S.C. § 326, with the combined total compensation not to exceed the statutory maximums provided by 11 U.S.C. § 326; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Application for Compensation by Eggleston & Cramer, LTD. is APPROVED and it is ALLOWED compensation in the amount of \$456.00, and that the Chapter 13 Trustee is authorized to pay such allowed fees in accordance with the Chapter 13 Plan and as statutorily provided.
