<u>ORDER</u>

SUSTAINING THE DEBTOR'S OBJECTION, DENYING U.S. BANK'S MOTION TO FILE A LATE CLAIM, AND CONVERTING THE JUNE 18th CONFIRMATION HEARING TO A CASE STATUS HEARING

For the reasons set forth in the memorandum of decision of even date, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Debtor's Objection* is sustained and the Amended USB Motion is denied.
