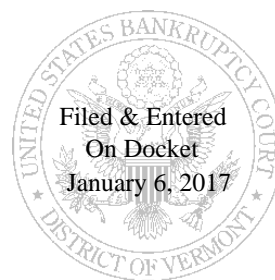

**ORDER**


**GRANTING THE PLAINTIFFS' MOTION FOR EMERGENCY HEARING,**  
**DENYING DEFENDANT'S MOTION TO DISMISS ADVERSARY PROCEEDING,**  
**GRANTING JUDGMENT ON THE PLEADINGS, IN FAVOR OF THE PLAINTIFFS,**  
**EXTENDING THE AUTOMATIC STAY TO NON-DEBTOR ENTITIES, AND**  
**ENJOINING STATE COURT LAWSUIT FROM PROCEEDING AGAINST NON-DEBTOR ENTITIES**

For the reasons set forth in a memorandum of decision of even date, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED

1. the Plaintiffs' Motion for an emergency hearing and expedited relief are granted;
2. the Defendant's Motion to Dismiss is denied;
3. the automatic stay applicable to the Debtor is extended to encompass MHOP and Saronis with respect to the state court lawsuit;
4. the Plaintiffs are granted judgment on the pleadings: their request for an extension of the stay is granted, and consequently, their request for a temporary restraining order is determined to be moot; and
5. Manchester CP is enjoined from proceeding with the state court lawsuit until the bankruptcy stay in favor of the Debtor terminates, as a matter of law, or it obtains relief from stay to proceed.
