
GENERAL ORDER 00-2

Pursuant to Bankruptcy Rule 9036, Notice by Electronic Transmission, the Clerk may utilize Electronic Bankruptcy Noticing (EBN) (that is, noticing via facsimile or e-mail), if the party receiving the notice submits a written request for such electronic transmission. This court has determined that the written request requirement must be fulfilled by use of an Electronic Noticing Agreement. This Agreement is executed by the receiving party and the Clerk, and when complete, is filed by the Clerk with the Bankruptcy Noticing Center (BNC).

Accordingly, it is ORDERED that the Clerk will provide Electronic Noticing Agreements to any entity requesting this service. Indeed, these agreements have already been mailed to court users as part of Clerk's Announcement 00-108, dated October 5, 2000. The terms and procedures for EBN are detailed in the Noticing Agreement itself and in Clerk's Announcement 00-108. These procedures may be amended from time to time, and court users will be notified accordingly.
