

THE INTEREST OF COURT SECURITY )

The taking of photographs, the use of radio, television or other broadcasting facilities, and the operation of tape recorders anywhere in the Bankruptcy Court facilities, located on the second floor of Opera House, 67 Merchants Row, Rutland Vermont, are prohibited, except with express permission of the Court.

The taking of photographs and the use of, or operation of, such photographic or audio recording equipment in any courtroom, hearing room, or corridor adjacent thereto during the progress of, or in connection with, judicial proceedings, including proceedings before a United States Trustee, whether or not Court is actually in session, are absolutely prohibited. A Judge may, however, permit (1) the use of electronic or photographic means for the presentation of evidence or the perpetuation of a record, and (2) the broadcasting, televising, recording, or photographing of investitive and ceremonial proceedings.

This Order is effective immediately.
